



SPCC GUIDELINES FOR REQUESTS FOR AUSPICES

Purpose

SPCC welcomes requests for auspices from organisations planning educational activities aligned with its mission to improve cancer care through innovation, collaboration, and knowledge sharing. The aim is to support high-quality initiatives that benefit the international oncology community.

Eligibility criteria

To be considered for SPCC auspices, your event must:

- Address a topic of strategic interest for SPCC
- Demonstrate potential impact within the oncology field
- Target an international audience
- Be developed independently, with scientific rigour and no commercial bias
- Avoid mono-sponsorship or promotional content
- Reflect SPCC's values of quality, inclusiveness, and patient-centred care

Benefits of SPCC auspices

Events granted auspices may benefit from:

- Visibility via SPCC's institutional websites and newsletter
- Promotion through SPCC's social media channels (LinkedIn, Instagram, Facebook), where appropriate
- Use of the official SPCC Logo
- Opportunity for future collaboration or expert involvement

Visibility and reciprocal support
